

Opened in prayer – Gary Watson

Minutes of last meeting – Don motion to accept, Richard second. Motion passed.

<u>Treasurer Report</u> – National Rally final report. Amazing accomplishment of spending slightly more than income.

Fall Financial report – Dick thanked everyone for turning in the payment envelopes so we can keep track of what is spent. Leroy motion to accept, Karen W. second. Motion passed.

<u>Budget</u> – Dick reported a 2022 budget was passed this morning in the Executive Meeting. He noted the budget follows the calendar year for consistency. Jan motion to accept, Fred second. Motion passed

Food Service – Karen M. said the amount has gone up this year because of the rise in grocery costs. It does include paper products, fellowship meals, and anything needed for meals. It does not include items for snacks as that is all donated. Karen W. motion to accept, Richard second. Motion passed.

<u>Project Report</u> – Leroy said the list of projects was included in the packets and asked for questions. There were none. He thanked everyone for helping on the projects and participating in other projects that they have done. Don motion to accept, Jan second. Motion passed.

<u>Chaplain report</u> – Francie thanked everyone for stepping up to give devotions and for praying for our prayer requests. Having volunteers makes the job much easier. Jan thanked Francie and John for stepping out and contacting people regularly to keep in touch and to check on everyone. Terri motion to accept, Fred second. Motion passed

<u>Sewing Ministry</u> – Jan reported the sewers have worked on evangelism projects, have made curtains for our work projects and done whatever was needed where ever they were. Jan reported she has almost run out of the cards that go on the bears and evangelism dolls. COM also completed 150 aprons and bags for national rally. ADJUSTMENTS TO THIS SCHEDULE MAY BE NECESSARY

<u>Old Business</u> – Background checks: John reported nothing has been done about this because of rally workload. The discussion was tabled until spring rally.

<u>New Business</u> –

1. COM needs a nomination committee for 2022. We need 3 – 5 volunteers for this committee. Don Kragness, Fred Riley, Karen Watson and Paula Riley volunteered. Don is the chairman and he made a few comments about the election. Election will be held at Fall Rally 2022.

2. Discussion by membership to dispense some of the surplus money in the COM account to ISBA camps. There was a recommendation from the Executive Committee to keep \$5000 in the COM account and hold in reserve \$5000 each for Lake Sallateeska and Streator until they are ready to use their money for designated projects. John said when we go to some of our work projects, we are ending up helping with project expenses and that is one of the purposes for retaining the \$5000 in the account. The spring rally where we have the auction will also add money to the COM account. Karen M. motion to accept the recommendation, Leroy second. Recommendation was accepted by membership present.

3. Schedule – 2022

February 11 & 12 – February Fling April 3 – 8 - Lake Sallateeska April 24-29 – Indiana to help Indiana COM with a project (possibly) May 15 – 20 - Streator June – National Rally 6 – 9 June 26 – July 1 - possibly Otterville July 17 – 22 – Galesburg August 21—26 - Carmi September 18 – 23 – possibly Hamilton, IL October 19 – 22 – Fall Rally in Lake Sallateeska December 3 – Christmas Luncheon

Other possibility – John said a manager from Indiana wants to know if we can come help build a cabin. John will tell him that we don't know right now.

Highland Lakes - would like some help with projects .

A church in Barrington has been asking us to help their church but we don't think we can do it.

4. ISBA Annual Meeting - John needs volunteers for the COM table. Watson's, Riley's and Evans' volunteered.

5. Discussion on the food service for work projects: The Food Service COM position has become a large job requiring more work than originally intended. There was a discussion about how it could be changed to be more manageable and cost less to the COM budget. Karen will re-work the by-laws description. Jan motion to table the discussion until Christmas Luncheon, Anita second.

6. Don asked for permission to pay extra to some of the groups that helped with the National Rally and were not paid or had a small honorarium and incurred a major expense. Dick motion to accept, Leroy second. Recommendation approved.

Motion to adjourn – Don. Leroy closed in prayer.
