
Chaplain's corner by Francie Lindeman

They are providing financial help, equipment for tech, speakers and devotional leaders, have hosted the on-line registration process, have assisted with the printing of the t-shirts for volunteers and attendees and have been a huge blessing to all of us in many, many ways. May God bless them for leadership and assistance to us and to God's church.

National Rally 2021 Updates:

The DuQuoin fairgrounds have asked that we not come in to camp until Monday because they will be having a huge event the weekend before.

1. Volunteer t-shirts are in and available from Don Kragness. They will be \$9 per shirt. Don will have them in April during our work week at Lake Sallateeska.

2. Summary of Rally registrations as of 3-31-2021:

144 people registered and more coming every day (57 camping units + 10 in hotels)

15 states represented

279 meals have been sold

\$13,443 in registration fees & meals sold

\$3,558.70 in expenses

- 3. Cookies and snacks are still needed for refreshment time and for the children's area. Please make sure that they are individually wrapped to meet health guidelines. Please contact Francie Lindeman (618-713-2402) or Jan Kragness (618-922-5549) for more information or to volunteer to help. Invite your church to be part of filling this need.
- 5. The hospitality bags will be packed at the April work week. If you are working on any project or items to be included in the bags, please bring them or contact Sondra McKenzie (618-889-1950).
- 6. The Fairground Inn (a motel at the entrance to the DuQuoin fair grounds) has reopened and is willing to offer a discount rate for those attending the rally. Their rate is \$70 per night plus tax. If you are interested in attending the rally and are not planning to bring your camper, you might consider this option. Call them directly for reservations and tell them you are attending the rally to get the discount.
- 7. The decision has been made to extend the registration deadline to May 15 due to the continuing registrations coming in and the hope that more will feel safe to come with the increase in numbers of those who have been fully vaccinated.


