Betty is doing well and helping her son take care of her grandson.

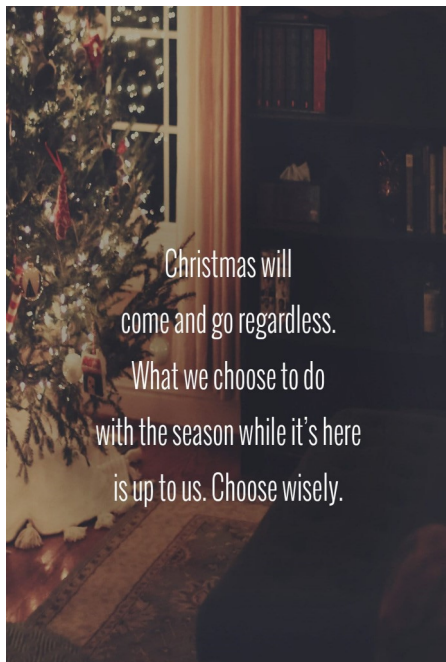

Much work was accomplished and many blessings will come from it.



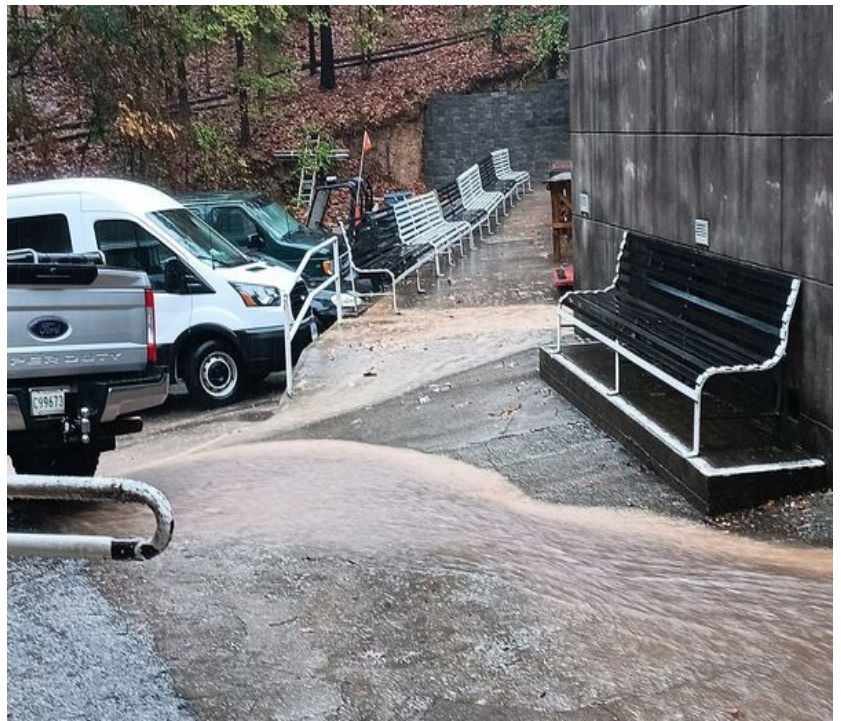


New flower boxes were built for the marketplace area. They will look so nice filled with flowers for next summer.

You know the “bear factory”?

These little bears are making a big impact on the places they go. They are seen at the Baptist Children’s Home Fall Festival, MorningStar Mission, 2 hospitals in southern Illinois, places where there is a need for comfort and lately at a church where the children listened intently to the message of salvation from the bear tags. They are carried in our cars, motorhomes, trucks and always available when a need comes up.

The last church encounter has prompted a church to inquire how they can help to support the factory efforts by donating funds for everything needed to make bears for a year. Our sewing committee is doing their research on what that cost would be. It takes fabric, stuffing, ribbon, evangelism outreach cards and thread for the physical needs and many, many hours tracing patterns, cutting, sewing, stuffing, sorting the cards, sewing up the back and choosing a ribbon to tie on the cards.

This is a project of love and happens at work projects and in many homes during the year preparing for our “factory” time together.

Many women (and many men) have been part of this ministry. Even if you don’t sew, you can help in other ways. They are not toys but tools for the Lord.

Thank you for any part you have played in the “bear factory” and the out reach ministry it has. Pray for those little bears as they enter the world and spread the Good News of the gospel.

To fill the current requests for bears, we need more people to help. During our long winter days, we can still be part of the COM “bear factory” ministry by cutting out bears or gathering supplies or stuffing bears while we watch TV at night. There are hurting people of all ages that we meet that need the message that the bears give and we want to be ready.
