
Illinois Campers On Mission

<u>Friday night</u> – There was fellowship time and an evening meal. Francie conducted an informal meeting with the women about the food service position and how we will handle the food for the coming year. We will also ask the churches where we are working to provide meals when possible. It helps the ladies of the church with purpose and also gave them an investment in what we are doing. We will not change the job description for Food Service Director for now and see how things work out. Meals will continue to be lighter at noon.
