

COM Backgound Checks

Illinois COM Executive team has made the decision to begin backgrounds checks for COM members. This was done because we want to show our good faith in assuring the places where we work that we are concerned about child safety and are doing our due diligence to be committed to prove that to them.

We clearly realize that most places where we work <u>MAY</u> require their own background check be done as well, but we are doing the best we can to meet the expectations they may have for volunteers.

The cost is \$10 per background check and the results are good for three years or may be done sooner if requested. We have chosen to work with a company called Background Checks.com which is a reputable non-profit organization also used by IBSA.

Background checks are not mandatory for COM members but it is a service we are choosing to offer to our members. If you are interested in having yours done, please send me an email and I will get the form to you. It is a very simple form and you just return it to me and I will get the process completed. The company does require your personal signature, social security number, date of birth, address and full name on the form before I can submit it to them. All information you provide is kept in a locked file case and will never be shared or used for any other purpose. I will send you a copy of the report and a pocket size laminated card you can carry to show you have been checked and where someone can contact if they have questions. May God guide and protect us and the people we work with by the completion of these background checks.

Tasks completed at Otterville

<u>Basement bathroom</u> – removed and replaced door, enlarge doorway, replaced toilet with high rise model, install handicap bars, replace the toilet flange and put up new signs on the door

<u>Kitchen area</u> – cleaned and swept floor, washed out cabinets and appliances

<u>Entry deck and ramp</u> - removed and replaced deck flooring, steps, and railings and built a small entry platform into the building

<u>Upstairs bathroom</u> - removed a wall between bathroom and adjoining storage room, rebuilt wall to give more space to the bathroom side, framed with new dry wall, taped and mudded wall on both sides, painted both rooms, replaced toilet with high rise, installed new larger door and handrails, put on new door signs

Doors—Sanded and stained 2 interior doors used in bathrooms

<u>Curtains</u> - purchased curtain rods and curtains for 5 windows, hemmed them and hung <u>Baptistery</u> - built and installed steps to both sides of the baptistery, stained and installed hand rails

<u>Cleaned</u> outside of exterior air conditioner, cleaned up floors and surfaces from all work projects

Sewing ministry—Sewed and stuffed As You Go bears

Evangelism outreach—Visited with and witnessed to neighbors of the church

Bible study—Attended Sunday night bible study and Wednesday night prayer meeting

Water fountain—Removed old water foundation and installed new water fountain in the hallway Additional bathroom—Replace toilet in additional upstairs men's restroom, put up new signs
