A note from Francie, the COM Food Coordinator for 2022

We are going to try something a little different this year to ease the burden on the past food coordinators. We have decided on a few changes that you will want to know as you prepare your camper for each mission work week.

- 1) We will continue to have the group meal at noon
- 2) We will strive for a lighter meal that will fill our stomachs followed by devotions
- 3) We will ask for any churches that host us for a work project to also provide our noon meals (if possible). The Project Coordinators will pass this along to them as the project is discussed. COM will continue to prepare our own meals at the camps and Children's home.
- 4) If IL COM is providing the meal, the food coordinator will decide on the menu and then will work with those attending that week to help provide parts of the meal and/or crockpots, electric skillets, etc. if needed for cooking the meal.
- 5) Snacks will continue to be provided by the campers attending. Everyone is asked to bring a snack item to share (crackers & cheese, fresh fruit, cookies, sausage log, hard boiled eggs, candy, etc.) We do ask that you have them prepared to set out to serve if possible or plan to do that when it is served. COM will provide tea and water to drink.
- 6) We will plan eating out sometimes in the evenings and will let you know early.

REMEMBER THIS IS A TRIAL RUN AND ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE MADE AS NEEDED!! PLEASE BE PATIENT AND FLEXIBLE WITH US.

Glory to His name. Glory to His name. There to my heart was the blood applied. Glory to his name.


