Please take note of the change of dates and places for the September work project.



National Rally 2023 has a home—our neighbors to the north, Michigan.



### Tasks Completed:

#### <u>Ranch</u>

Remove climbing wall at challenge course and store materials in enclosed barn. Seal challenge course decks Seal challenge course and low ropes benches, walls, etc Rebuild outer barn foundation with treated beams from climbing wall frame Seal ranch house deck Paint ranch house basement Cut and remove dead pine trees. Cut and split wood at challenge course

#### **Campus**

Remove door and frame at Mathias. Install frame, door, closer and panic bar. Reinstalled electric strike and alarm in unison with beams alarm, prime and paint (enamel) new front door and frame at Mathias.

Prime and paint (enamel) front and back doors at Garrison cottage

Repair and paint dormers on Hathaway, caulk primer and paint

Cut some Russian olive and foliage around Garrison and Ford and stack on back side of levee.

#### **Administration Bldg**

Trim crabapple at driveway Trim elongated trees at 4 corners of administration bldg. Landscape off of roof.

#### Grace Haven, Mt Vernon, II

Frame and install shorter basement windows to bring above ground level to redirect groundwater. Brick exterior void under windows.

Install 200' of perforated drain pipe around building and retaining wall Cover with 1" rock. Put downspouts into existing drains or outside retaining wall.
